Second Collections

June 16th and 17th: Peter's Pence Collection

Next weekend, our parish will take the Peter's Pence Collection along with the other parishes in our diocese and around the world. Pope Francis has shared with us that "There is always someone who is hungry or thirsty and who needs me. I cannot delegate this to another. This poor person needs me, my help, my word, my commitment. We are all involved in this" (General Audience, Oct. 19, 2016). The Peter's Pence Collection provides Pope Francis with the funds he needs to carry out his charitable works around the world. The proceeds benefit our brothers and sisters on the margins of society, including victims of war, oppression, and disasters.

For example, in Nyamirambo, a suburb of Kigali, Rwanda, the Salesian Sisters of the Sacred Hearts run the "Filippo Smaldone" Institute. Here the sisters provide poor, hearing-impaired and vulnerable children with an education. Without this education, these children would live their lives on the margins of society, and never be fully integrated into it. But with contributions from the PPC, the institute's building will be expanded and renovated completely to allow more children to attend classes and lectures, giving them a brighter future of hope. This is just one instance of the many ways in which the Peter's Pence Collection provides hope and help to those most in need.
