Berea Faith Community Outreach, Inc. is an association of churches (including St. Clare), community organizations and active and retired clergy working in the Berea area. BFCO administers three aid programs—BUURR, Food Bank, and the Frank Gailey Transient Aid Fund—to meet the housing, nutritional and other material needs of at-risk individuals and families in the community. Through the BUURR program, BFCO provides partial assistance with rent and utility bills.

**CCD Is Underway!**

CCD, or the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, was an association established in Rome in 1562 for the purpose of providing religious education. Today, CCD refers to a religious education program of the Catholic Church, usually designed for children. St. Clare children receive their faith formation through our CCD program, which consists of class study and preparation for reception of the Sacraments. The goal of the parish CCD program is to enable and encourage the students to learn more about their faith.
