SECOND COLLECTION

The Opportunities for Life Collection this weekend, on January 19 & 20, is taken up in all four Kentucky dioceses during the week of the anniversary of Roe vs. Wade (January 22), as part of the Kentucky bishops' unified message advocating for a pro-life culture in Kentucky. In the Diocese of Lexington, funds from this collection will provide resources to pregnant women and new families in crisis, including material assistance, parenting education and ongoing emotional support. Catholic Charities staff will offer these services to women and families across our Diocese.
