**THE BROWN SCAPULAR**

The Brown Scapular is a gift to you from your Heavenly Mother. In 1251, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite, in Aylesford, England. She handed him a brown woolen scapular and said, “This shall be a privilege for you and all Carmelites, that anyone dying in this habit shall not suffer eternal fire.” In time, the Church extended this magnificent privilege to all the laity who are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites and who perpetually wear it.

To be eligible for the scapular promise, one must be enrolled in the Brown Scapular Confraternity. The simple enrollment ceremony will be performed here at St. Clare during the 8:00 a.m. Mass for the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Friday, May 31. You will need a scapular that is 100% wool. A few are available here at St. Clare.
